GENERAL (AMENDMENT) LOCAL LAW 2008 No. 13.

Frankston City Council resolves:

1.1 Local Law

This Local Law is –

- (i) a local law made under Part 5 of the Local Government Act 1989;
- (ii) called General Local Law 2008 No. 13.

1.2 Objective

The objective of this Local Law is to amend General Local Law 2003 No. 7 to make provision or better provision for –

- (i) the peace, order and good government of the municipality; and
- (ii) the protection and enhancement of the amenity and environment of the municipality.

1.3 Commencement

This Local Law commences on the day following the gazettal of the Local Law in the Victoria Government Gazette.

1.4 Amendment of Local Law

On the commencement of this Local Law, General Local Law 2003 No. 7 is amended in accordance with the provisions of this Local Law.

1.5 Application of Local Law

This Local Law applies throughout the municipality.

1.6 Use of Vehicles in or on Municipal Places, Public Places and Roads

Sub Clause 2.11(b) of General Local Law 2003 No 7 shall be amended by replacing the words “municipal place” with the words “public place”.

1.7 Dangerous and Unsightly Land and Nuisances

(a) Sub Clause 3.1(b) shall be deleted from General Local Law 2003 No.7

(b) The following Sub Clause 3.1(b) shall be inserted in General Local Law 2003 No.7

“3.1(b) is not deemed unsightly by an authorised officer by the excessive growth of grass, noxious weeds or undergrowth.”

1.8 Heavy and Unregistered Vehicles

(a) Sub Clause 3.5(a) of General Local Law 2006 No 7 shall be amended by inserting the word “tonnes” after the expression “4.5”.

1.9 Infringement Notice

(a) Sub Clause 6.2.3 shall be deleted from General Local Law 2003 No. 7.

(b) The following Sub Clause 6.2.3 shall be inserted in General Local Law 2003 No. 7:

“6.2.3 The amount to be paid under an infringement notice is:

(a) Clause 2.11(b) Use of Vehicles in or on Public Places and Roads, Clause 3.1A Dilapidated Building, Clause 3.1B Aerosol Spray Paint Containers and Clause 3.6 Building and Works Code of Practice:

- (i) First Offence – 2 penalty units; and
- (ii) Second Offence – 5 penalty units.

(b) Clause 3.12.2 Collection of Hard Waste, Garden Waste and Recycable Materials and Clause 3.13 Noise – 5 penalty units.

(c) Any other infringement - 2 penalty units.

Resolution for the making of this Local Law was agreed to by Council on 7 April 2008.
