GENERAL (AMENDMENT) LOCAL LAW 2009 No.16.

Frankston City Council resolves:

1.1 Local Law

This Local Law is –

- (i) a local law made under Part 5 of the Local Government Act 1989;
- (ii) called General (Amendment) Local Law 2009 No.16.

1.2 Objective

The objective of this Local Law is to amend General Local Law 2003 No. 7 to make provision or better provision for –

- (a) the peace, order and good government of the municipality; and
- (b) the protection and enhancement of the amenity and environment of the municipality.

1.3 Commencement

This Local Law commences on the day following the gazettal of the Local Law in the Victoria Government Gazette.

1.4 Amendment of Local Law

On the commencement of this Local Law, General Local Law 2003 No. 7 is amended in accordance with the provisions of this Local Law.

1.5 Application of Local Law

This Local Law applies throughout the municipality.

1.6 Animals - Numbers

- (a) At the commencement of Clause 4.1 of General Local Law 2003 No 7, the number 4.1.1 shall be inserted.
- (b) The following Sub Clause 4.1.2 shall be inserted in General Local Law 2003 No.7:
 - “4.1.2 The maximum number of cats or dogs allowed to be kept on land shall be five (5), unless a town planning permit issued under the provisions of the Frankston Planning Scheme allows a greater number.”
