# Taking the Whole Organisation on the Waste Reduction Journey with the Trim Your Bin Program

Frankston City Council, Mornington Peninsula Shire Council and the City of Casey partnered to deliver the Trim Your Bin Program, which aimed to increase circularity in the local commercial sector by supporting local businesses who were looking to reduce waste, save costs and protect the environment.

Palliative Care Southeast offers compassionate palliative care services throughout Melbourne's southeast metropolitan region. With a strong commitment to implementing sustainability throughout their facility, and their onsite social enterprise café, 80VC the team signed up to the Trim Your Bin Program to find out where else they could improve.

#### Benefits and results

41% reduction in waste going to landfill representing 3.120 tonnes annually. This is roughly equivalent to 156,00 takeaway coffee cups a year. 57% increase in recycling representing 3.120 tonnes annually.

## How Trim Your Bin helped

A Trim Your Bin assessor visited Palliative Care South East to estimate the volumes of material in their bins and provided a tailored action plan to achieve a reduction in waste going to landfill and increase recycling output.

### Actions taken

- Implementation of new bins and improved signage to address specific issues, including contamination in internal recycling bins and the incorrect disposal of garbage bags in external commingled skip bins
- Delivery of waste and recycling training for staff and cleaners on correct separation of waste, emphasising that items should always be placed loose, without being bagged
- Introduction of collection for food waste and coffee grounds for composting onsite to feed garden beds and offering free coffee grounds for local home composters
