DOMESTIC RAINWATER TANKS – REGULATORY INFORMATION

With Victoria's weather patterns, rainwater tanks are becoming increasingly popular and particularly as the demand for water becomes greater. Should you wish to install a rainwater tank, the following guidelines / requirements must be considered.

Permits

- Town Planning If the rainwater tank exceeds 4,500 litres, or is proposed to be located in an
 area covered by a Heritage Overlay or where it could impact on/ require the removal of
 vegetation, comments should first be obtained from Council's Statutory Planning Department on
 phone 1300 322 322.
- Building Domestic rainwater tanks do not require a Building Permit as they are not classified as a building. However, if the tank is contained within, or on, a proposed building or supported by an existing building a Building Permit will be required.

Drainage

 Rainwater tanks allow for the storage of some of the stormwater from the roofed area of your house and/or outbuildings. However, the tank must be fitted with an overflow pipe, of the same diameter as the inlet pipe, which must be connected to a stormwater drainage system that discharges to a legal point of discharge. General

- Installation of the rainwater tank should be completed in strict compliance with the manufacturer's specifications and recommendations.
- The rainwater tank must be installed by a licensed plumber.
- Rainwater storage tanks are permitted to project into the minimum setback from a side boundary, required by Building Regulation 414, by 500mm. This means that tanks up to 3.6m in height must be a minimum of 500mm from a side boundary. Tanks in excess of 3.6m in height will need to be setback at a distance greater than 500mm from a side boundary, depending on the site.
- Approval from the relevant authority must be obtained should the proposed rainwater tank be constructed over an easement.
