Most items that can't go in your recycling or food and garden waste bin go in your garbage bin, unless they can be recycled in other ways (see over page for 'Other waste and recycling services').

Hard Waste

Waste and recycling service guide



Lifestyle Capital of Victoria



Frankston City Council provides a range of waste and recycling services for local residents, including:

- Kerbside garbage (collected weekly) and recycling (collected fortnightly)
- Food and garden waste (optional, collected fortnightly)
- Additional garbage, recycling and food and garden waste bins available for an extra charge
- Eligible residents can apply for an additional recycling bin, free of charge
- Hard waste collection
- Frankston Regional Recycling and Recovery Centre (local transfer centre)

STEP 1: Recycle right

These items go in your recycling bin: ✓

After your recycling is collected, it gets taken to a facility where it is sorted for recycling.

Some items can't be separated out at this facility. These items are considered contaminants and should not be placed in your recycling bin.

All items must be clean of food waste and liquids.

Plastic bottles and containers



Paper and cardboard



Glass bottles and jars



Steel and aluminium cans, foil and trays



STEP 2: Green is good

These items go in your food and garden waste bin: ✓

Garden prunings, grass clippings and weeds



Small branches



(maximum size 10 cm diameter x 30 cm length)

Fruit and vegetable scraps



Seafood, meat scraps, dairy and bones



Leftovers



Please refer to the recycling guide sticker under your bin lid. If you don't have one, please contact Solo Resource Recovery. Phone 9775 1909.

Council inspects the contents of recycling bins. If your bin is contaminated, it may not be collected until the contaminants have been removed.

If in doubt, leave it out.



NO clothing or textiles



NO household rubbish



NO polystyrene foam



These items are considered contaminants and MUST NOT go in your recycling bin:



NO plastic bags or other scrunchable plastics (even if they have a recycling code) — they can be recycled in other ways



NO bagged recyclables



NO nappies



These items MUST NOT go in your food and garden waste bin:



NO packaging



NO plastic, glass or recyclables



NO pet droppings



NO bricks, rubble, soil or turf
