# Cafe Creations & Coffee Course

Our Café Creations & Coffee hospitality training program is designed to give participants entry level skills for employment in the hospitality industry or provide a pathway to further education and training. This course runs over 4 weeks, Monday to Wednesday 9am - 3pm.

Come and gain valuable hospitality industry skills and experience with our hands on, pre-accredited Barista training programs including **Barista Basics** and **Crash Course Coffee**. *Barista Basics* provides an introduction to the fundamentals of coffee making while *Crash Course Coffee* builds on these skills and includes customer service, taking cafe orders and more coffee making practice. These courses run over 2 days, 9am - 3pm.
