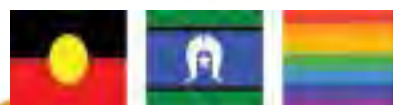
Are you interested in facilitating a Community Playgroup? Perhaps there isn't a playgroup running in your area and you would like to start one?
