

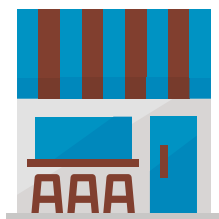
Safety and Reducing Harms

Perception of safety in public spaces

Through our Community Satisfaction Survey 2021 we heard that:

Impact of COVID-19:

Due to COVID-19
pandemic restrictions

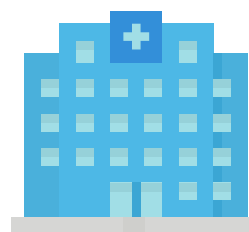
