

Carrum Downs Recreation Reserve & Wedge Road construction update

Frankston City Council has appointed Ramsay Civil Pty Ltd to undertake construction of the new 149 space car park at Carrum Downs Recreation Reserve as well as upgrades along Wedge Road to improve access and safety for local residents and visitors to the reserve.

Car park construction is nearing completion and is expected to be open to the public by 20th April. Some works will be continuing in the reserve as part of the new public toilet construction near the play space.

Upcoming works along Wedge Road:

- Construction of new roundabout at the Herbert Road / Wedge Road intersection including reserve entrance upgrades
- New raised asphalt pedestrian crossing near the Cadles Road roundabout
- Stormwater drainage upgrades including kerb and channel construction
- New street signage and line marking

Timing:

Works are planned to take place between 29 April 2024 and 24 June 2024 (subject to weather conditions) and will be undertaken between 7am and 4pm, weekdays. There will be four (4) night shifts in the final two weeks of the works program to perform the final asphalting along Wedge Road and a small section of Herbert Road. This is to avoid the need for any road closures during the day time.

Disruption during works:

The construction works will require the closure of one lane of Wedge Road at a time and detours may be in place whilst works are undertaken on the new roundabout at Herbert Road. This will cause some delays along Wedge Road during this period and alternate routes around the area are recommended where possible to reduce travel times and impacts.

Traffic management will be in place to safely direct traffic and to allow access to properties. Properties will be accessible at all times during construction, however some minor delays may be experienced.

A moderate amount of noise can be expected during construction whilst machinery is being operated.

Every effort will be made to reduce disruptions as much as possible but we suggest planning ahead to allow extra travel time.

Access to Carrum Downs Recreation Reserve

During construction, all vehicular access to the reserve will only be via Cadles Road. The entrance to the reserve at Herbert Road will be closed.

Pedestrian access along Wedge Road and to the Carrum Downs Recreation Reserve will be altered during construction works. Please follow pedestrian signage.

How will the community benefit from this project?

- Increased road safety along Wedge Road for drivers and pedestrians.
- Enhanced pedestrian and vehicular access to the Carrum Downs Recreation Reserve and its facilities.
- 149 new car parking spaces at the Carrum Downs Recreation Reserve to cater for busy periods.

The \$2.35M project is funded by the Australian Government through the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Fund in partnership with Council.
