

# Learn Local Success Story: Josh's Journey to Employment

Through dedicated coaching, phase training, and career exploration, Josh gradually built the skills and confidence needed to take the next step.

As part of his journey, Josh undertook our Learn Local Cafe Creations & Coffee course, a four-week program where he gained hands-on experience in hospitality, customer service and developed valuable workplace skills. With renewed confidence, Josh worked on his resume and actively applied for jobs, ultimately securing an entry-level role as a Food Services Attendant in aged care.

One year on, Josh remains in his role and is thriving, demonstrating resilience and growth in both his professional and personal development. His journey is a testament to the power of tailored support, skill-building, and confidence in unlocking new opportunities.
