

METHODOLOGY STATEMENT:

This track audit has been carried out by Pollen Studio Landscape Architects in collaboration with Frankston City Council.

The first step of the audit involved compiling base information from a variety of sources, including Council GIS layers, a feature and level survey, and maintainence regime documents. The second step involved walking of the tracks physically with internal Council Stakeholders taking notes on scaled plans. This first draft will require input from other stakeholders and additional ground proofing.

This document is intended to be read in conjunction with the Walking Track Audit Matrix, which was developed with reference to Institute of Public Works Engineering Australasia's (IPWEA) Condition Assessment and Asset Performance Guidelines.



RATING 1 - VERY GOOD







RATING 1 - VERY GOOD:

Paths both aesthetically and functionally "as new" with very functional drainage solutions, appropriate for a wide variety of walkers and runners. Generally not steep, or utilises steps. Edges of tracks clear.

Surface levels are even. Seating, rest areas are well placed, enhancing user comfort and convenience.

Overall, this part of the network sets a high standard for accessibility, usability, and aesthetics, promoting active transportation and community engagement with nature.

RATING 2 - GOOD








RATING 2 - GOOD:

Tracks both aesthetically and functionally high standard with adequate drainage solutions. Surface generally even although some erosion of ground surface, or slipperyness of boardwalk may exist. Edges of path usually clear.

Overall, this part of the network sets a decent standard for accessibility, usability, and aesthetics, promoting active transportation and community engagement with nature.







RATING 3 - FAIR:

These point features and parts of the track network are functional but less aesthetically pleasing and may be on the way to lower functionallity. Surface generally even although some erosion of ground surface, or slipperyness of boardwalk may exist. Edges of path not always clearly defined. Paths generally may be more succeptable to further degredation.

RATING 4 - POOR







RATING 4 - POOR:

These point features and parts of the path network has some usability issues. Gravel surfaces show signs of wear, needing targeted repairs, and further rainfall may cause deeper erosion. Furniture items are in need of upgrade or repair.

Some of these items may require repair, others would benefit from redesign or retrofit, to avoid the same outcome occuing again in a short timespan.

RATING 5 - VERY POOR







RATING 5 - VERY POOR:

This part of the path network has general usability and safety issues. Gravel surfaces show signs of wear, needing general repairs, and further rainfall may cause deeper erosion. Furniture items are in need of upgrade or repair. Steps may be trip hazards. Drainage solutions may be failing or unfit for purpose. Tree roots may effect path surface.

Some of these items may require repair. Others would benefit from redesign or retrofit, to avoid the same outcome occuing again in a short timespan. To be assessed for replacement or removal by Council.

RATING 6 - REQUIRES IMMEDIATE ATTENTION:

This part of the path network has general usability and safety issues. Gravel surfaces show signs of wear, needing general repairs, and further rainfall may cause deeper erosion. Furniture items are in need of upgrade or repair. Steps may be trip hazards. Drainage solutions may be failing or unfit for purpose. Tree roots may effect path surface.

These items pose a sefty risk and require immediate attention. Some of these items require immediate repair or removal. Others would benefit from redesign or retrofit, to avoid the same outcome occuing again in a short timespan. To be assessed for replacement or removal by Council.
