Frankston Youth Service's "WHAT Bus" is a mobile youth centre, aimed at supporting young people 12-24 years old. Other Ways to get involved

L2P Learner Driver Mentor Program

Supporting young Learner drivers who don't have access to a mentor driver or vehicle to help them gain 120 hours of driving experience

Fresh Entertainment

A group of young people who organise music and other events around Frankston. A Recording Studio is also open for young people to use.

Youth Hangouts

Safe spaces for young people to hang out and seek support and/or friendship. Activities are also run from these centres.

Youth Events

Events for youth and families, including skate competitions, pool parties, open days and more.

Street Art

A program connecting young people to their community and services while building skills and resilience through art.

Advice and Referral

Assistance for young people living, working or studying within Frankston.



School Holiday Programs

Inclusive, fun activities for young people aged 12 – 17 years. Program information and bookings are released prior to school holiday breaks.

In School Programs

Frankston Youth Service also run programs in schools, such as lunchtime programs and skills based programs.

Youth Council

A youth advocacy group who provide advice, suggestions and recommendations to the Council on a range of issues that may affect young people in the local community. They also manage projects and undertake volunteering.

NexGen (Youth Advisory Group)

Young people who meet together with youth workers to co-design programs and events for young people in Frankston.
