






### TOP SIX INDUSTRY SECTORS IN FRANKSTON CITY





# **UNEMPLOYMENT RATE** June 2022, in comparison with September 2022 scorecard





% of 15-64 age population



In Frankston City there were 268 residential and other dwellings approved to be built in the financial year 2022-23 (current data available until Nov 2022)




