FRESH RECORDING STUDIO PROGRAM

Background

The Fresh Recording Studio exists as a safe and relaxed space for young people to express themselves creatively and learn skills in audio production.

The studio program creates partnerships between young musicians and volunteer audio engineers to produce tracks in the Fresh recording studio located at Ebdale Community Hub. Some of these tracks are featured on Fresh's annual compilation album and performed live at the album showcase event.

The Fresh Recording studio is free of cost to young participants and is funded by Frankston City Council Youth Services and the Victorian Government's FReeZA program. We at Frankston Youth Services FReeZA program are grateful to the Volunteer Audio Engineers who make studio projects possible for young people in our community.

Volunteer audio engineer hours are flexible and volunteers have access to studio facilities Monday to Friday 9am-9pm for their own projects outside of their volunteer role. Volunteer audio engineers and music producers are supervised by Youth Services FReeZA Program facilitators and can be offered training or networking opportunities of benefit to them. Volunteers must be 18+ years old and are subject to an application, criminal history check, Working with Children Check, and interview process.

- Experience Audio Engineering in Fresh Studio
- Network with other audio engineers and artists
- Participate in end of year volunteer celebration and studio compilation album showcase
- Working with young artists and/or budding audio engineers who otherwise may not have access
- Develop and further your skills
- Participate in training opportunities
- Studio access outside of the volunteer role
- We work with your availability with no weekly minimum or maximum commitment

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 18+ year old
- Experienced audio engineer (Ableton and/or Pro Tools)
- Ability to work collaboratively with young artists and youth services
- Passionate about music, arts and culture
- Reliable and cooperative
- Willingness to learn
